The purpose of the Referral for Active Intervention (RAI) service is to help improve the safety and well-being of children and their families.

RAI is a free and confidential service available to families who have children under 18 in their care.

RAI is a supportive service designed to build on family strengths and improve family relationships.

Who is this Service for?

Parents and families who require assistance around increasing the safety and well-being of their children and family, and have been referred by a government department.



What is Involved?

If RAI is recommended to you by one of the following government departments, Communities (Child Safety Services), Housing and Homelessness Services, Education or Health we will contact you to discuss if you would like to participate. The program is voluntary. Therefore you do not have to participate if you choose not to.

If it is decided that you would like to participate in the program, we will arrange a suitable time and place to meet. You do not need to come to our venue. We can come and meet you at a location that is suitable for you and your family.

The Benefits

- Improve parenting skills.
- Develop coping skills for dealing with difficult family issues or crisis.
- Encourage children to attend and do their best at childcare and school.
- Better manage household duties, such as cooking, cleaning and budgeting.
- Improve self esteem and feel more confident as a parent or care-giver.
- Improve the relationships within your family.
- Access health and welfare services, including doctors, counsellors, drug and alcohol services, sexual health services and child health specialists.
